Please note that colts will not be eligible to play in matches until they have paid their subs and coaching fee in full.

How to Pay

Sports Equity Monitoring

Sport can and does play a major role in promoting the inclusion of all groups in society. However, inequalities have traditionally existed within sport, particularly in relation to gender, race and disability. Sport England is committed to promoting and developing sports equity, which is about fairness in sport, equality of access, recognising inequalities and taking steps to address them. By monitoring the profile of young people in sports clubs, national governing bodies of sport and Sport England can identify any issues relating to under-representation of different groups and can together develop strategies to ensure that all young people have the opportunity in the future to develop and progress in sport.

Photographs and Filming

In addition to seeking consent (on the attached form) to photograph your child and subsequently publish on the Club's web site, a further consent is requested in relation to filming your colt for coaching reasons. Coaches may now want to film your colt in action at training or at matches in order to assist in improving skills and techniques. The films taken will be played back to your colt to demonstrate where / how they could improve their cricketing technique, after which any recordings taken will be deleted.

Selection Ethos and Playing Up

At Old Wilsonians the ethos of the club is that every colt should have an opportunity to play in at least some of their age-appropriate matches. Where two teams have been entered into an age category (for the 2018 season this will be the U13s and U15s) there will be an A and a B team. The A team will be a competitive team and the selection process will be on merit; selection for the B team and for the U9, U11 and U17 teams will be rotated when necessary to ensure as fairly as possible that all colts get match play experience.

Occasionally there may not be enough colts in the correct age group to make up a team. On such occasions the Club at its discretion, taking into account ability and safety, may ask a colt to "play up". If a colt is asked to play up by just one year (i.e. an 8 year old to play up in an under 11 match) then verbal consent of the parents or carers will suffice. Where a colt is asked to play up two years (i.e. a 7 year old to play up in an under 11 match) the parents and carers written consent is required.

Data Protection

The Club will use the information provided on this Membership Form (together with other information it obtains about the player) to administer his/her cricketing activity at the Club and in any activities in which he/she participates through the Club and to care for and supervise activities in which he/she is involved.

In some cases this may require the Club to disclose the information to County Boards, Leagues and to the England and Wales Cricket Board. In the event of a medical issue or child protection issue arising, the Club may disclose certain information to doctors or other medical specialists and/or to police, children's social care, the Courts and/or probation officers and, potentially to legal and other advisers involved in an investigation.

As the person completing this form, you must ensure that each person whose information you include in this form knows what will happen to their information and how it may be disclosed.

Batting Helmets

It is part of an English Cricket Board directive that children must wear protective helmets.

Automatic Non- Voting Membership Status

Junior membership of the club also provides that the parent(s) / carer(s) / guardian(s) of the child are given non-voting membership of the club as part of that junior membership. This entitles the parent(s) / carer(s) / guardian(s) no additional privileges that would otherwise be gained by paying the appropriate adult membership fee(s).
